Dear Friends and Supporters,

2024 was a year of **incredible growth, deepening impact, and continued commitment** to serving families facing homelessness with dignity and holistic care. Our focus remains on serving families intensively and sustainably, leading to **strong long-term success rates**. Even when families face new challenges, we continue to walk alongside them, providing the support they need to stay housed and move forward.

Last year, we served 343 families, including 933 children each one met with compassion, tangible support, and a path to stability (not to mention the community to support families who encounter hurdles and barriers on that path). **We saw a 25.5% increase in total individuals served** compared to the previous year, despite the challenges of rising housing costs and economic uncertainty. Our model continues to prove that **community-driven solutions work**.

Because of your support—including volunteers who gave 21,620 hours of their time, as well as individuals, congregations, and businesses who rallied together behind this mission—families not only found homes but built futures with stability and hope.

As we look ahead, we remain committed to strengthening our holistic approach, expanding housing stabilization programs, and deepening our partnerships with community members and local leaders. **The need is great, but together, we can continue to make a lasting difference.**

OUR PROMISE: Community Impact

The Need

- The average rent for a two bedroom apartment in Wichita, KS is \$1,004 per month, which equals **\$12,048** per year. A single parent working full time at minimum wage in Wichita earns only **\$15,080** per year.
- Family Promise of Greater Wichita receives an average of 200
 calls per month from families experiencing housing insecurity.
 These families are seeking support to avoid or exit homelessness.

1,965 Children in USD 259 don't have a permanent residence

The Impact We Made Together

- In 2024, our transformative programs brought 343 families hope and helped 933 children.
- FPGW Volunteers gave 21,620 collective hours of their time to provide support for families.

OUR PROMISE: Focused Support



Family homelessness comes with unique challenges that require specialized solutions.

Parents facing homelessness must navigate overwhelming barriers like finding affordable housing, securing reliable transportation, maintaining employment, and accessing affordable childcare—all while trying to keep their family safe and stable. At Family Promise of Greater Wichita, we understand these challenges and provide targeted support to help families overcome them. Here's how we walk alongside families on their journey to lasting stability:

- ADVOCATING and mediating for families navigating complex challenges and programs
- **PREVENTING** evictions with financial assistance and partnership
- **SECURING** housing for families experiencing homelessness
- **ENSURING** families have support while addressing root causes of housing insecurity
 - **CONNECTING** families to long-term assistance and vital resources
 - **PARTNERING** with landlords to help families find stable housing
- **COLLABORATING** with other organizations to expand options and enhance support
- **SUPPORTING** families through their housing search and move-in process
- **PROVIDING** hands-on guidance from shelter to permanent housing
- **FERSONALIZING** plans for long-term stability and independence
- **OFFERING** crisis intervention and in-home case management
- **LEVERAGING** local, regional, and national resources for lasting family success

By offering proactive support—like rental assistance, financial coaching, and community resources—we can stop these crises from becoming catastrophes. Prevention isn't just compassionate; it's the most effective way to keep families housed and ensure that children grow up with stability, security, and hope.

Hope for Families Experiencing Housing Insecurity

Families at risk of either losing their home or having to enter a shelter, who are in a position to attain stability with a little bit of assistance and support, are met with tangible assistance, case management, and opportunities for future community with Family Promise of Greater Wichita.

OUR PROGRAMS: Crisis Intervention




The Promise to offer support and community during times of uncertainty and hardship.

When a family experiences homelessness, they need more than just a place to sleep—they need support, community, and a path forward. Through our shelter services program, Family Promise of Greater Wichita provides safe, temporary housing while helping families regain stability.

Our unique rotation model brings together a network of faith communities and volunteers who open their doors and hearts, offering meals, encouragement, and a true sense of belonging. This collaborative effort surrounds families with the support they need to move beyond crisis, rebuild their lives, and step into a future filled with hope and stability.

Hope for Families Experiencing Homelessness

Each family that seeks shelter with FPGW enters the flagship Rotation Program. Families with longer term barriers might eventually move into Bridge to Housing - a static shelter model - to make room for additional families in Rotation and be empowered to clear final hurdles to housing.

OUR PROMISE: Changing the Story for Families

These stories from 2024 highlight the transformative impact of Family Promise's programs and the continued importance of collaboration, support, and small interventions in helping families achieve lasting stability.

One Shelter family found an **unconventional housing solution**, overcoming the typical barriers families face in securing stable housing. Through a partnership with several other agencies, FPGW was able to connect this family with positive living arrangements and a support system. This not only helped put a roof over their heads, but also sparked a meaningful conversation about the importance of working together to find innovative solutions for families experiencing homelessness. Their journey highlights how **collaboration can be a game-changer** for vulnerable families seeking stability.

A motivated mother with a **steady job** faced significant challenges in becoming stable. Though she had a good work ethic and was doing her best, **high transportation costs**—primarily spent on LYFT rides to daycare and work—were draining her finances. After a brief stay in our Rotation Shelter, she was able to move into our Bridge to Housing (BTH) program, where she began saving money and took a big step toward independence. With support from Family Promise, she received a "Keys for Success" vehicle, dramatically changing her ability to manage her life and work. This story is a testament to how **small interventions can lead to big, life-changing shifts** for families in need.

Sometimes, **the road to stability requires more than just a roof over your head**—it demands guidance and a holistic approach to overcoming barriers. One mom came to us through our rental assistance prevention program, seeking not just housing support but help with navigating the challenges holding her back. Over seven months of case management, we were able to help her **secure better employment, move out of a substandard living situation, and access resources to meet her family's needs**. With the support of our community partners, her children received clothing and she was able to furnish her new home with essential items. The most important change, however, was the newfound peace of mind she gained, allowing her to focus on her children and secure autism services for her son. **She is proud of her progress, and we are proud of her resilience and determination.**

For families who graduate from our shelter program, we know that **continued support is crucial to long-term success**. After reintegrating with her son and graduating from shelter, one mom received support for her phlebotomy class, which set her on the path to employment. Two and a half years later, she is still employed and stably housed. Recently, **a small misunderstanding about a utility bill put her at risk of eviction**, but with a \$100 intervention, we were able to prevent her from losing her home. This story demonstrates the **power of extended support and how a small gesture can make a world of difference in maintaining housing stability.**

OUR FINANCIAL PROMISE

At Family Promise of Greater Wichita, we manage our efforts with integrity and a deep commitment to the families we serve. Thanks to the growing support of our community, we invest more in families each year—tackling big challenges with bold action and unwavering hope.

While we work tirelessly to meet the needs of today, we also plan for the future, ensuring that Family Promise will always be here to walk alongside families in crisis. Every dollar entrusted to us is used to strengthen programs that create lasting stability and bring us closer to a future where no child experiences homelessness in Wichita.


True impact is measured in decades, not just a year.
